Navigating the intricate dynamics of family businesses presents unique challenges and exciting opportunities. This panel session, "Unpacking Family Businesses Governance: Key Challenges & Opportunities," delves into the essential governance practices to help family-owned enterprises thrive in an increasingly competitive world. This session will draw on the experiences & insights of those who serve on boards of listed family businesses, highlighting the incremental stewardship responsibilities of such directors.

3. Reimaging Your Board Career Plan

Gain an insider's perspective on how boards are strategically planning for board director renewal and systemic introduction, moving away from traditional retirement and replacement strategies. RRA has supported the placement of more than 500 directors to boards in the past year, what insights can be shared from RRA's experience in placing over 500 directors to boards? What strategies can candidates use to differentiate themselves in a competitive selection process?

4. The Evolution of Board Effectiveness Exercises - From Regulatory Obligations to Performance Optimizers for the Elite Boards

Skepticism vs. proactive engagement and deliberate design. This panel session will delve into the perception of board reviews and self-assessments, as well as the benefits of focusing the exercise on improvement rather than solely evaluating past performance. It will also explore emerging technology and platforms that can help transform these processes into strategic tools for sustained board performance in the long run.

5. Cultivating Executive Success: The Board's Strategic Role

Boards have transitioned from solely judging and overseeing their CEO and senior executives to becoming active coaches, developers, and supporters. They recognize their crucial role in fostering conditions for the success of senior executives. How boards are fulfilling this role? What are the strategies to support and develop new CEOs and top teams effectively?
